The school is introducing a new 'Ethos', so there is involvement with preparing that, and there will be future involvement in helping deliver classes and assemblies relating to this.

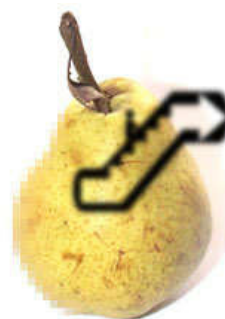
Hilton & Cauldeen Primaries
